

Recommendations of the Campus Safety Measures Working Group

1. Improve communication so our community has a better understanding of what campus safety resources are available, such as campus safety escorts, and are equipped to make smart choices. This will require using several different communication modalities and sharing multiple messages throughout the course of a student's career at Rhodes.

3. Although students, faculty, and staff generally feel very safe on West Campus. To improve the sense of safety

- a. Increase the signage and visibility of the Education Building.

- c. Have a marked Campus Safety vehicle present after dark. Encourage any club activities to students in attendance can take advantage

4. Continue working with the city of Memphis in enhancing safety on North Parkway Street and at the intersection of North Parkway.

5. We do not recommend the addition of a few armed guards on campus at this time, although we recognize this is an issue that needs to be addressed. The only way to prevent an armed assailant would

any such incidents will continue as they have in the past provided active shooter drills are conducted over the summer.

6. Work to make our officers continue to receive training in techniques, and training

7. Continue to explore ways in which the community could help around the exterior of buildings to climb over the fence

8. Rhodes currently has a CARE team that provides extra support to members of our community facing various challenges. We will add a separate, highly trained threat assessment and management team specifically tasked to work with individuals who may pose a danger to themselves, others, or the Rhodes community.
